Subject matter and area covered

Cotswold District Council has prepared a Local Plan and Policies Map which it proposes to submit to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government. The Local Plan relates to the whole District and provides a strategy for delivering growth for Cotswold District up to 2031. The document provides the vision, objectives, strategic policies, development management policies and site specific allocations for delivering new homes, jobs, services, facilities and infrastructure.

Period for representations

The period for submission of representations will run for six weeks from **Monday 27th June 2016 until Monday 8th August 2016**. Representations should arrive no later than midnight on Monday 8th August 2016.

Anonymous comments or comments received outside these dates will not be accepted.
