

Siddington Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (Regulation 16)

Cotswold District Council is seeking views on a proposed neighbourhood development plan for **Siddington**. The Plan has been prepared by the Parish Council with the help of the local community; it seeks to address town planning issues that local people have identified as important in the area.

All comments will be forwarded for consideration by an Independent Examiner. If the Plan passes examination, it will be put to a local referendum and residents, who are registered to vote, will get a say on whether the local planning authority should use the Plan to help determine planning applications in the Parish.

We are publicising the Plan for a period of 6 weeks. It is planned to begin on **Thursday 16th July 2026** and ending at **midnight on Wednesday 26th August**.
