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To whom it may concern

South Cerney Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan covering the whole of its parish area. The Plan sets out a vision for the future and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally. This plan has been submitted to Cotswold District Council, and is subject to a six week consultation period, prior to being considered by an independent examiner. The examiner will consider the plan and its supporting evidence, and review the representations made. Should the examiner find that the plan meets with the Basic Conditions, it will proceed to referendum next year. Should more than 50% of votes cast support the plan, it will be made.
