<p>Project name and location: Remedial work to improve and maintain the pond on Tattle, the Common between Nether and Church Westcote.</p>	
<p>Brief description of works undertaken: <u>V Tyack &amp; Sons</u> The work carried out on Tattle consisted of draining the top bank above the pond by excavating a 30m trench and laying a perforated land drainage pipe, cushioned with bedding and made good. The pond itself had had the reeds and silt cleared, clay excavated to plug any holes and the site tidied and made good.</p>
